- Saturday evening, October 12 at 5:00 p.m. – Dinner Dance Cotillion



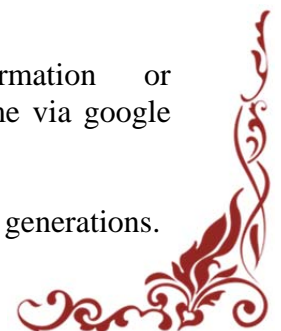
**REQUIREMENTS:**

- Debutante may select to be presented by her father, grandfather, brother, or other person approved by the event chairpersons.
- Debutante's presenter must wear a black tuxedo and black tie.
